ENGINE

Horsepower. Once you get some, you always want more. That's why Durango features the available 5.7-liter HEMI® V8 engine with a best-in-class 335 horsepower and 370 lb-ft of torque. Other engines and features:

- 3.7-liter V6 provides 210 HP and 235 lb.-ft. of torque
- The 4.7-liter engine has 235HP and 300lb.-ft. of torque
- Choice of four- or five-speed



SMOOTH RIDE

To get a really smooth ride out of most vehicles you need to pay more to get a better suspension system. With Durango, the smooth ride comes standard. That's because every Durango features a long wheelbase and wide track, a coil-sprung solid-axle rear suspension with a Watt's linkage to control lateral motion, rack-and-pinion steering, torsion bar independent front suspension, and a hydroformed box-section frame for added stiffness.

AIR BAGS

Durango features an advanced air bag system that includes multistage front air bags along with an occupant classification system (OCS)* for the passenger-side front air bag; in addition, an available side-curtain air bag system helps protect all three rows of seating.

The OCS* measures the conditions for activation or deactivation of the passenger-side air bag based upon the weight of the occupant.

Finally, Durango features adjustable head restraints and shoulder belts in all seating positions.

TOWING AND HAULING

You can pack plenty inside Durango's 102.4 cubic feet of cargo volume and up to 1,790 pounds of payload. Want more? The optional HEMI® engine gives you best-in-class 8,950 pounds* of towing capability. Or opt for one of two other powerful engines:

- 3.7-liter V6 with 3,850 pounds maximum towing capacity
- 4.7-liter V8 with 7,500 pounds maximum towing capacity*

SEATING

Are you one of those people who think SUVs are a dime a dozen? Odds are you've never been inside the one-of-a-kind Dodge Durango. If you had you'd know about its unique seven-passenger seating, and available folding 60/40 split third-row seat that makes room for longer items. Other features include:

- Available heated cloth - or leather-trimmed front bucket seats
- Generous overall head, leg, shoulder, and hip room
- Best-in-class* cargo room behind the second row of seats
- An enormous 102.4 cubic feet of maximum cargo capacity when the third-row seats are folded
- Reclining second-row seats (leather only)

STORAGE

Moving companies won't have the same clout after seeing the Durango's 102.4 cubic feet of cargo space. The second and third rows of seating fold flat into the floor, creating a four-foot-wide rear opening and a maximum payload of up to 1,790 pounds.†

Getting the show on the road has always been a production. Until now. An easy-to-use DVD rear entertainment system (also plays CDs and mp3s) with a clear, 7-inch active matrix screen is available on Limited and SLT "G" package.

AUDIO

Durango's sound system lineup features an AM/FM/six-disc integrated CD/mp3 changer (optional on SXT, SLT, and Adventurer, standard on Limited) and a 368-watt eight-speaker Alpine sound system (optional on SLT, standard on Limited). It has enough juice to make your home stereo play the blues. Plus, an available GPS navigation radio on Limited provides turn-by-turn directions with full-screen map displays, automatic reroute calculation, compass heading, and more..

ALL-WHEEL DRIVE

Two available all-wheel-drive (AWD) electronic shift transfer cases—single speed and two speed—are engaged at all times and controlled by a switch on the instrument panel. Both provide traditional part-time four-wheel drive for maximum traction on slippery surfaces. Best of all, standard full-time AWD "set-it-and-forget-it" is always there when you need it.

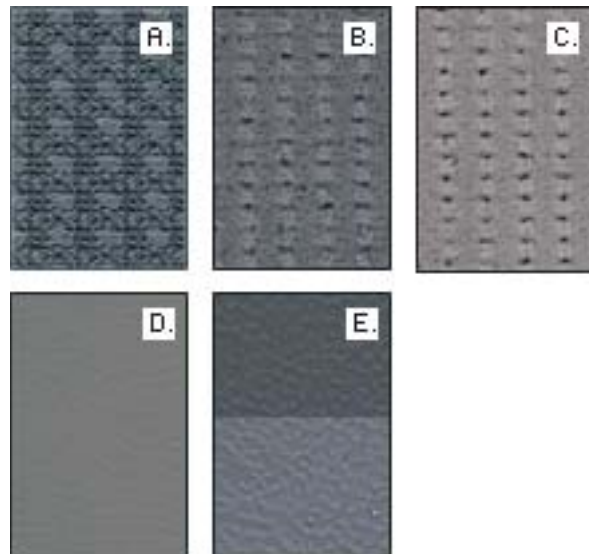
