The other, of similar material, is split down the center to give a sporty right-and-left-seat effect. Body cloth is a jacquard-weave fabric. Fury III 4-Door Sedan in Light Turquoise Metallic








Fury I 4-Door Sedan in Bronze Metallic




Fury I Station Wagon in Black





Options, Accessories and Engines

1—Air Conditioning. Gives you "controlled weather" inside, no matter what's going on outside. Features Chrysler Corporation's own reheat principle. Responds quickly to setting changes.

2—Special Wheel Covers. "Deep-dish" in construction, ultra-modern in appearance. An optional must for that "custom" touch.
3—Auto Pilot. Set the dash-mounted pointer to your pre-selected speed, and this ingenious control does the rest. Maintains set speed regardless of hills or declines. Even nudges your foot gently when pre-set speed is reached.

There are also 26 two-tone exterior color combinations available in Sport Fury. Interiors are all-vinyl, and are available in Blue, Tan. Red Metallic, Citron, or Black. Sport Fury interior shown on Page 4.

Fury III—There are also 17 solid exterior body colors available in Fury III for '66. The selection is the same as that listed for Sport Fury. 21 two-tone exterior color combinations are also available in this Fury series. Cloth-and-vinyl interior trim is featured in some models, in Blue, Turquoise, Tan, Red Metallic, or Citron. All-vinyl interiors are obtainable in Blue, Turquoise, Tan, Red Metallic, Citron, or Black. Body cloth is a jacquard-weave fabric of colorful design. Fury III interior shown on Page 9.

Fury II—11 solid exterior colors are offered in the Fury II series. They include Black, and White, and all other colors shown, except Dark Green Metallic Citron Gold Metallic, Soft Yellow, Yellow, Light Mauve Metallic, and Silver Metallic. 14 two-tone exterior color combinations are also available in this series. Sedan interiors feature cloth-and-vinyl trim combinations in Blue, Turquoise, Tan, or Red Metallic. The cloth is a shaft-loomed fabric of ribbed texture. Wagon interior trim is all-vinyl, in any one of the same four colors. Fury II interior shown on Page 18.

Fury I—Solid exterior colors for the Fury I series are the same as those offered for Fury II. 9 two-tone exterior color combinations are also available in this series. Sedan interiors are cloth-and-vinyl in Blue, Tan, or Red Metallic. Cloth is a jacquard-weave fabric, with a linear pattern of small diamonds. Wagon interiors are all-vinyl in the same three colors. Fury I interior shown on Page 15.

*IMPORTANT NOTE: All solid exterior colors except Silver Metallic, where offered in a series, are considered standard equipment. Silver Metallic, however, and all two-tone paint combinations, are optional at slight additional cost. Black or white vinyl roof coverings are also available for some models as an extra-cost option. 




